

TITUS 2 DISCIPLESHIP MINISTRY FAQ

- 1. Why is this women's discipleship ministry called "Titus 2"?**

The Titus mandate was given to the young pastor Titus by Paul in Titus 2:1-5. He instructed Titus to equip older women in the congregation to teach the younger women.
- 2. What is the purpose of this ministry?**

The purpose is to help women establish covenant relationships with other women, learn to think biblically about womanhood, and learn to apply biblical principles to relationships and circumstances.
- 3. What is the curriculum?**

For 2022 we will be studying *Adorned* by Nancy DeMoss Wolgemuth. Each participant will purchase their own book.
- 4. Is there homework?**

Participants are encouraged to read the assigned chapter and be prepared to discuss it.
- 5. What will we do at the meetings?**

In addition to discussing the assigned chapter, we will spend time getting to know each other, sharing prayer requests and praying for one another.
- 6. How long is the commitment if I join a group?**

Commitment is for 12 months and runs from February 2022 to January 2023.
- 7. Is this ministry just for young mothers?**

No! Single and married women of all ages are invited to participate.
- 8. Why is it called "spiritual mothering"?**

Because T2D is a nurturing ministry
- 9. How many women are in each group?**

There will be 6-8 women in each group.
- 10. Are women grouped by age or interest?**

Neither! You sign up for a *time* that is most convenient for you. We hope there will be diversity of ages, interest, spiritual maturity, and experiences in each group. We are all sisters in Christ and the experience will be richer if we have the opportunity to get to know women in a variety of life-seasons and circumstances.

11. Does someone have to be a member of the church to join a group?

No. This discipleship is opened to any woman who has a desire to come alongside an older woman and be encouraged and equipped to live for God's glory.

12. Who are the T2D Spiritual Mothers?

The definition of a spiritual mothering relationship is as follows:

“When a woman possessing faith and spiritual maturity enters into a nurturing relationship with a younger woman in order to encourage and equip her to live for God's glory.” Susan Hunt in *Spiritual Mothering, The Titus 2 Model for Women Mentoring Women*. p.36
