DESIGNATED FUND PROCESS

It is very important that each ministry leader fully understand the new procedure so we encourage you to contact a member of Stewardship should you have any questions.

Designated funds are different than budget funds.

- Designated funds are accounts, on paper, that track special events or purposes for which monies have been raised outside of the budget. For example, a specific mission trip or church project. Some represent ongoing activities (e.g. Debt Retirement); some represent annual activities (e.g. Lottie Moon) and some represent specific activities or projects (e.g. Missions -Local).
- Budget funds are the funds approved annually by the church membership for the operation of the different ministries at Fairview Baptist Church. These funds are primarily used for annual operating costs such as electricity, teaching materials, software, etc.

Donations/Event Funding:

- While some events may be funded via the church budget the majority of
 mission trips are funded via donations, personal gifts and personal fund
 raising. To ensure we are complying with the appropriate tax guidelines
 please follow these simple rules.
 - Tax Deductible:
 - Trips/Events where the purpose is to serve.
 - Contributions should be made payable to the church and not the individual.
 - Contributions should include:
 - Name of giver
 - Intended recipient or note the contribution is for general use
 - Event name (i.e. Hungary Mission Trip)
 - Designated Fund/Accounting Code if possible
 - Non-Tax Deductible:
 - Those events where the purpose is to be served or where the attendee gains something of value (i.e. Wednesday Night Supper; purchase of a ticket for an event).
 - Payment may be made payable to the church.
 - Payments should include:
 - Name of giver
 - Intended recipient or note the contribution is for general use
 - Event name (i.e. Women's Christmas Dinner)
 - Designated Fund/Accounting Code if possible

What we're asking of you.

- 1. Please apply the correct designated fund or budget codes when submitting expenses/deposits/donations/gifts for your ministry.
- 2. Ministry leaders and staff should clearly communicate the appropriate designated fund code that givers should reference when organizing trips/events/activities that call for deposits/donations/gifts. For example, if John Thomas donates \$100 to send Jane Doe to Hungary in 2019 the designated fund would be "Missions 2831 Hungary" and the entry note would read; "Jane Doe Hungary 2019".
 - a. In addition, notify givers that funds which might remain in a designated fund after all the expenses associated with a specific trip/event/activity have been paid will be available for general use within the fund at the discretion of leadership. Monies will not be "banked" for individuals in anticipation of a future need.
- 3. Please do not confuse designated fund codes with budget codes.
- 4. For those instances where there is a lack of clarity about what to do, either reach out to Stewardship, the church Treasurer or Assistant Treasurer for clarification. We will be happy to assist.
